ORDINANCE 7-2005

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING NO PARKING ON DEBOLT STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF NEWTOWN AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READING

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown, in order to provide for safe streets, the free movement and access of emergency vehicles, and safe lines of sight distances, wishes to establish a no parking area on Debolt Street in the Village of Newtown;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. Due to the indiscriminate parking of motor vehicle and to insure the free movement of emergency vehicles and safe lines of sight distance on Debolt Street, a dedicated street in the Village of Newtown, there shall be no parking on either side of Debolt Street from State Route 32 to the terminus of Debolt Street.

SECTION 2. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.


