ORDINANCE 8 - 2006

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FULLER FORD
FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MAINTENANCE TRUCK**

WHEREAS, the Village of Newtown is a participant in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program, and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that separate bids for the purchase of a Ford F150 truck would exceed the price available through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to acquire from Fuller Ford through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program one (1) 2006 F150, in an amount not to exceed \$14,315.50.


SECTION 4. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary vehicles to the Newtown Maintenance Department in a timely manner.


