ORDINANCE 12 - 2006

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER
TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SMITH & WESSON
FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT WEAPONS, DISPENSING WITH
THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown wishes to purchase new weapons for the police department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to acquire from Smith & Wesson, twenty M&P 40 caliber semi-automatic handguns, in an amount not to exceed \$9,000.00. The funds for such purchase shall be appropriated from the Drug Offenders Fines Funds.

SECTION 2. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary weapons to the Newtown Police Department in a timely manner.


