ORDINANCE 07 -2007

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE POLICE CHIEF AND DISPENSING WITH THE THIRD READINGS

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 737.15 requires that the Village Police Chief must become a resident of the Village of Newtown within six months of taking office unless such requirement is waived by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown desires to waive such requirement for the current Police Chief, Thomas Synan, as Chief Synan will be moving from the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. The residency requirement for Police Chief Thomas Synan is hereby waived, provided that Thomas Synan shall establish his residence within a five mile radius from the geographical boundaries of the Village of Newtown.

SECTION 2. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.


