ORDINANCE #9 -2007

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR VILLAGE PERSONNEL, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish rates of pay and salaries for Village personnel commencing March 29, 2007:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

Effective March 29, 2007, the following persons shall be paid the wage set opposite their respective names:

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

SECTION 2. Wages for persons beginning employment with the village in the ensuing year shall be as follows:

	Starting Wage
Police Lieutenant	\$26.00
Police Sergeant	\$24.75
Patrol Officer	\$20.75
Part Time Officer	\$12.25
Maintenance Technician	\$13.00

SECTION 3. All regular full time employees of the village, after five (5) years of continuous service, shall receive longevity pay of \$25.00 per year for each year of continuous service, up to a maximum of \$500.00. Employees will receive longevity pay in the first pay period of December each calendar year, following the completion of five (5) years of service.

SECTION 4. The position of the Assistant to the Mayor shall be compensated at the rate of \$54.65 per hour for all work performed on behalf of the Village. The position being part time, no benefits other than those required by federal and state law shall be provided.

SECTION 5. Each member of the Village of Newtown Property Maintenance Formal Appeals Board shall be compensated at the rate of \$50.00 per meeting for each meeting of the Village of Newtown Property Maintenance Formal Appeals Board that he or she attends.

SECTION 6. The Mayor shall be compensated at an annual rate of \$5,000.00. Such amount shall be paid quarterly for that portion of the quarter during which such person is in office.

SECTION 7. Each Council member shall be compensated at an annual rate of \$3,000.00. Such amount shall be paid quarterly for that portion of the quarter during which such person is in office.

SECTION 8. An employee receiving advance permission from the Mayor or his or her Supervisor, and who uses his or her personal car for Village Business, shall be reimbursed \$.45 per mile.

SECTION 9. Except as indicated above, hourly rates of pay and salary increases for this Ordinance are effective as of March 29, 2007 and are retroactive to that date. The rates of pay prior to that date shall remain in effect until the pay rate change on March 29, 2007.

SECTION 10. All other matters pertaining to employment, personnel practices, benefits, disciplinary action, and grievance procedure should be referred to the Village of Newtown revised Personnel Practices handbook and the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 11. The Mayor is hereby authorized to hire temporary part time Police Officers to work for scheduled vacancies.

SECTION 12. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 13. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide for adequate and timely compensation to Village personnel.




