ORDINANCE 8 -2008

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR VILLAGE PERSONNEL,
DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish rates of pay and salaries for Village personnel commencing April 10, 2008;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

Beginning April 10, 2008, the following persons shall be paid the wage set opposite their respective names:

Police Chief Tom Synan	\$65,920.00/year
Lieutenant Shawn McBreen	26.03/hour
Sargeant Jim Vontz	25.15/hour
Patrol Officer Spencer Bischoff	24.05/hour
Patrol Officer Jeff Braun	24.05/hour
Patrol Officer- Full Time Lateral Hire	24.05/hour
Patrol Officer- Full Time New Hire Probationary	20.44/hour
Patrol Officer Kent Orso (part-time)	13.39/hour
Patrol Officer Robert Hueber (part-time)	12.88/hour
Patrol Officer Richard Kaiser (part-time)	12.88/hour
Patrol Officer Mike Wedding	12.62/hour
Any other Part Time Patrol officer hired after April 10, 2008	12.62/hour
Maintenance Supervisor/Street Commissioner/ Cemetery Sexton Michael Schmidt	\$45,000.00/year
Technician 2 Tony Baxter	15.97/hour
Technician 1 Robert Beson	14.94/hour

Any Technician 1 hired after April 10, 2008	13.00/hour
Fiscal Officer Keri Everett	\$44,000.00/year
Court/Police Clerk Lorna Rose	43,004.00/year
Administrative Assistant Becky Fairley	14.70/hour

SECTION 2. The position of the Assistant to the Mayor shall be compensated at the rate of \$54.65 per hour for all work performed on behalf of the Village. The position being part time, no benefits other than those required by federal and state law shall be provided.

SECTION 3. Each member of the Village of Newtown Property Maintenance Formal Appeals Board shall be compensated at the rate of \$50.00 per meeting for each meeting of the Village of Newtown Property Maintenance Formal Appeals Board that he or she attends.

SECTION 4. The Mayor shall be compensated at an annual rate of \$5,000.00. Such amount shall be paid quarterly for that portion of the quarter during which such person is in office.

SECTION 5. Each Council member shall be compensated at an annual rate of \$3,000.00. Such amount shall be paid quarterly for that portion of the quarter during which such member was in office.

SECTION 6. An employee receiving advance permission from the Mayor or his or her department head, and who uses his or her personal car for Village business, shall be reimbursed \$0.28 per mile.

SECTION 8. Except as may be indicated above, hourly rates of pay and salary increases for this Ordinance are effective as of April 10, 2008 and are retroactive to that date. The rates of pay prior to that date shall remain in effect until the pay rate change on April 10, 2008.

All other matters pertaining to employment, personnel practices, benefits, disciplinary action, and grievance procedure should be referred to the Village of Newtown revised Personnel Practices handbook and the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 9. The Mayor is hereby authorized to hire temporary part time Police Officers to work for scheduled vacancies.

SECTION 10. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 11. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary

for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide for adequate and timely compensation to Village personnel.


