ORDINANCE 13 -2008

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR INCREASED MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT TO VILLAGE EMPLOYEES, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown wishes to provide that Village employees using their own vehicles in furtherance of Village business be reimbursed at the rate established by the Internal Revenue Service as an allowable deduction for the business use of an automobile;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Village of Newtown employees using their own vehicles in the furtherance of Village business shall be reimbursed by the Village at the same standard mileage rate established by the Internal Revenue Service as an allowable deduction for the business use of an automobile.

SECTION 2. In order to qualify for reimbursement, an employee must first obtain approval from the employee's supervisor, the Mayor, or the Fiscal Officer to use the employee's vehicle in the furtherance of Village business. Mileage driven commuting to and from work for the Village shall not qualify for reimbursement.

SECTION 4. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the immediate increase in the reimbursement rate due to the rising cost of operating a vehicle while on Village business.


