

Ordinance No. 6-1985

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AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAID REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Newtown wishes to establish an Ordinance to provide for regulation of parking on residential property; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Newtown provides for the requirement for parking spaces upon residential property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF NEWTOWN, OHIO, that:

1. Each owner of property in the Village, shall provide the required number of spaces as set out in the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Newtown.

2. Each vehicle parked on residential property, shall be parked on a hard surface or gravelled section of the parking area designated pursuant to the Village Zoning Ordinance.

3. No parking shall be permitted on residential property in the yard, not hard surfaced or gravelled, and not specifically established as a parking area pursuant to the Village zoning regulations.

4. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for an owner or operator of a vehicle to be parked on any residential property in the Village of Newtown, not specifically established or declared to be a parking area or space.


5. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for an owner or occupant of any real property in the Village of Newtown to permit parking on any area not an off-street parking space, as designated pursuant to the Village zoning regulations.

6. There shall be excepted from the provisions of this Ordinance, parking on a lot, when such parking is for a function or affair conducted by a private property owner, religious, civic, or charitable organization, provided such parking has been approved by the Mayor or Police Chief.

7. Penalty: Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine, not to exceed \$100.00 for each and every vehicle parked in violation upon any lot.
