RESOLUTION NO. 2006 - 18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXPAYER ACCOUNTS, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown wishes to provide for the collection of delinquent taxpayer accounts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Regional Income Tax Authority (RITA) is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the collection of delinquent taxpayer accounts of the Village of Newtown. RITA is hereby authorized to deduct from next monthly distribution check to be paid to the Village the sum of \$1,000.00 to cover the extraordinary costs incurred in the collection of the delinquent accounts including court costs and wages and other costs of RITA employees working exclusively for the Village of Newtown in the collection of delinquent accounts.

SECTION 2. That RITA is authorized to employ the services of an independent law firm to aid in the collection of delinquent accounts and to pay such firm at a contingency rate of 25% of all sums collected by such firm. RITA shall verify all transactions associated with the use of an independent law firm and shall remit any fees due on behalf of the village from the month-end distribution. RITA shall identify these transactions on the month end close report.

SECTION 3. That RITA is hereby authorized to file civil litigation on behalf of the Village of Newtown in order to preserve and protect the interests of the Village in providing for the collection of delinquent tax accounts.

SECTION 4. The Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents and authorizations with RITA in order to more fully carry out the intent of this resolution.

SECTION 4.

The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least a three-fourths vote of all its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon the first reading.


SECTION 5.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the immediate collection of delinquent tax accounts.




