RESOLUTION 19 - 2006

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEASE/PURCHASE CONTRACT WITH CHARLIE'S DODGE FOR POLICE CRUISERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Newtown is a participant in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program, and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that separate bids for the purchase of Police Cruisers would exceed the price available through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to acquire from Charlie's Dodge through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program three (3) Dodge Chargers by Lease/Purchase.


SECTION 2. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary vehicles to the Newtown Police Department in a timely manner.




