RESOLUTION 06 - 2007

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CAMP SAFETY EQUIPMENT, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLE LIGHT BARS AND EQUIPMENT, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown wishes to purchase new light bars and equipment for police department vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Camp Safety Equipment, Inc. for the purchase and installation of lightbars and police equipment on the recently purchased police cruisers in the amount of \$20,659.32.

SECTION 2. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary equipment to the Newtown Police Department in a timely manner.
