RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 14

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE HAMILTON COUNTY NATURAL HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has established rules and regulations under 44 CFR Parts 201.6, which requires that “For disasters declared after November 1, 2003, a local government must have a mitigation plan approved pursuant to this section in order to receive HMGP project grants”; and

WHEREAS, The Hamilton County Emergency Management Agency has received a grant from FEMA to prepare such a mitigation plan entitled the “Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan – Hamilton County, Ohio” (HMP); and a CD copy of the revised HMP has been distributed to each jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in addition, it is understood that: “For multi-jurisdictional plans, there must be identifiable action items specific to the jurisdiction requesting FEMA approval or credit of the plan”; and

WHEREAS, the FEMA regulation 201.6 requires: “Documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan (e.g., City Council, County Commissioner, Tribal Council). For multi-jurisdictional plans, each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that it has been formally adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown, has reviewed the draft “Hamilton County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan”; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Village adopts the “Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan for Hamilton County; and

SECTION 2. The Hamilton County Emergency Management Agency shall prepare and submit to the Federal Emergency Management Agency in accordance with the draft rules and regulations published by FEMA, the Hamilton County Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

SECTION 3. The Fiscal Officer of the Village is authorized and directed to certify copies of this resolution to the Hamilton County EMA.


SECTION 4. The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least a three-fourths vote of all its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon the first reading.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is the timely adoption and implementation of the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.




