RESOLUTION 4 - 2008

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH KERRY DODGE FOR POLICE CRUISERS, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Newtown is desirous of acquiring three new 2008 Dodge Charger Police Cruisers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Newtown is a participant in the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined that separate bids for the purchase of Police Cruisers would exceed the price available through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village can purchase the three 2008 Dodge Charger Police Cruisers on equivalent terms, conditions, and specifications but at a lower cost, from Kerry Ford than through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to acquire from Kerry Dodge three (3) 2008 Dodge Chargers. The cost of acquiring all three vehicles shall not exceed \$83,000.00.


**SECTION 2.** The Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to provide the necessary vehicles to the Newtown Police Department in a timely manner.
