RESOLUTION 10 - 2008

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE IVY HILLS BOULEVARD AND PINEHURST DRIVE SURFACE SEALING IMPROVEMENTS, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND AND THIRD READINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Newtown is desirous of making pavement surface sealing improvements on Ivy Hills Boulevard and Pinehurst Drive in the Village (the "Ivy Hills Boulevard and Pinehurst Drive Surface Sealing Improvements Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village caused plans and specifications for the Ivy Hills Boulevard and Pinehurst Drive Surface Sealing Improvements Project to be prepared and advertised for bids as required by state law; and

WHEREAS, Terry Asphalt Materials, Inc. submitted the lowest and best bid in the total amount of \$92,875.00 in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Terry Asphalt Materials, Inc. was the lowest and best bid received;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newtown, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Terry Asphalt Materials, Inc. to provide for the Ivy Hills Boulevard and Pinehurst Drive Surface Sealing Improvements Project as set forth in the plans and specifications prepared by the Village for the Project.

SECTION 2. Such contract shall provide that Terry Asphalt Materials, Inc. shall provide and furnish all of the labor, materials, tools, expendable equipment, and all utility, insurance and transportation services required in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village, which plans and specifications shall be made a part of such contract.

SECTION 3. Subject to additions and deletions contained therein, the contract of price shall not exceed \$92,875.00.

SECTION 4. Council of the Village of Newtown, by at least three-fourths vote of all of

its members, dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on three separate days and authorizes its passage upon one reading.

SECTION 5.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Newtown. The reason for the emergency is to immediately provide for safe roads and streets in the village.
