

ISSUE 10 – PROPOSED TAX LEVY FOR NEWTOWN FIRE & EMS SERVICES

Newtown residents approved Issue 10 – Proposed Tax Levy for Newtown Fire & EMS Services.

This Tax Levy will replace the current levies being collected by the Little Miami Fire & Rescue District and is projected to provide Fire & EMS Services for about 10 years.

On November 4, 2015 Newtown Village Council approved a Resolution withdrawing from the Little Miami Fire & Rescue District.

The Village has a Letter of Intent to contract for Fire & EMS Services with the Anderson Township Fire Department beginning January 1, 2016. The Letter of Intent states that they will staff (4) Full-time Firefighter/Paramedics with all necessary equipment in the Newtown Fire Station, located on Main Street. Newtown Council firmly believes this to be the best safety and financial decision for the Village of Newtown.

We will keep you informed throughout this process but rest assured that we are committed to a seamless transition of service. Our primary focus is the safety and well being of everyone living, working or visiting our Village.
