

VILLAGE OF NEWTOWN STORM WATER UTILITY PROGRAM

On October 25, 2016 the Village of Newtown Council passed **Ordinance # 16-2016** that established a Storm Water Utility Program to initiate a dedicated funding source for our Storm Water Utility System. Every property owner will be assessed a Storm Water Utility Fee, billed through the Greater Cincinnati Water Works, to provide for the effective management and financing of the Storm Water Utility System within the Village.

The First Storm Water Utility Fee will be effective November 10, 2016 to February 15, 2017 and be included in the February billing due March 2017.

Classification of Property/Storm Water Utility Rates:

(A) Residential.

R-1 \leq ¼ acre shall pay \$3.25 per month

R-2 $>$ ¼ acre shall pay \$5.50 per month

(B) Non-Residential.

The square footage of the impervious area of an Equivalent Billing Unit shall be divided by the equivalent residential unit of 4,425 square feet multiplied by \$3.25 and that amount shall be paid per month.

Ex: If the impervious area is 25,000, the monthly Storm Water Utility Fee would be \$18.37 per month.
(25,000/4,425 x \$3.25 = \$18.37)

- Round Bottom Storm Water Pipe Replacement (Crushed and Non-Operational) \$91,219.80
- Ivy Hills Culvert (30" Storm Water Pipe Clogged and Non-Operational) \$31,879.21
- Miljoie Drive (30' of 18" Storm Pipe and Manhole Replacement) \$6,400
- St. Rt. 32 East Storm Water Pipe Replacement (Crushed, Undersized and Non-Operational) \$426,030
- Ragland Road Storm Water Improvements (Replace and Enlarge Storm Water Pipe, Headwall and Culvert) \$458,565
